

The Story Behind the Song: The Heart of Worship

Matt Redman wrote The Heart of Worship almost 30 years ago from his personal experiences. He was the worship leader at a megachurch in England. Their music and sound technology were world-class and cutting edge, but something was missing. One day, the pastor made a huge, controversial decision. This church with thousands in attendance every week packed away their expensive instruments and sound equipment.

The pastor realized they were doing all the right things, but they were not feeling all the right things. The music had become more about the people and what they want than it was about God and what He wants. Worship had become more about consuming a product than offering a praise. The pastor asked the question, "Can we worship God with nothing but our voices and our Bibles?" So that's what they did.

All of a sudden, Matt Redman, one of the greatest Christian songwriters in the world at that time, was out of a job. That's when he wrote *The Heart of Worship*. "When the music fades, all is stripped away, and I simply come longing just to bring something that's of worth that will bless Your heart... I'm coming back to the heart of worship, and it's all about You, Jesus. I'm sorry, Lord, for the thing I've made it when it's all about You, Jesus." At first, Matt wrote the song for his own private devotions. He said the song "nearly didn't go any further than my bedroom!"

The church learned the important lesson that worship "is not a product molded by the taste of the consumers. It is not about what we can get out of it; it is all about God." When Matt Redman shared the song he wrote with his pastor, the pastor decided it was time to bring back the band and sound equipment. Matt shared his song with the church, and it made such an impact that it spread all around the world.
